

Welcome to the 2020 riding season of Free Spirit Chapter® ladies motorcycle group! This year we celebrate our 25th year of ladies who ride safe, have fun, and grow friendships. We have a LOT of new things that will be happening in 2020, and welcoming new members is at the top of the list!

FSC® puts the safety of our members as a priority. To accomplish this, we ask that you complete and send the following information yearly (all of this is MANDATORY in order be a member):

- 1. Annual Membership Renewal Form
- 2. Complete the Waiver of Liability.
- 3. A copy of your valid Michigan driver's license showing your cycle endorsement.
- 4. A copy of your Proof of Motorcycle Insurance for the 2020 season. If your insurance expires during the course of the riding season, you will be asked to provide updated, current proof.
- 5. \$30.00 for yearly chapter dues (\$20 for lifetime members). Checks or money orders made payable to Free Spirit Chapter®.

Once all the above items are received, you will be added to the FSC Members only, where you will find all sorts of information about rides, events, photos, other member's contact information (yours will be included of course!), and just plain old cool stuff (3)

We also include the following forms that are **OPTIONAL** and **ARE NOT REQUIRED** for membership (again, for the safety of our members):

- Emergency Information Form. If you wish to include it, please fill it out, print it and keep it in your right saddlebag (preferably in a spot where it can be accessed quickly . . . placing it in a Zip Lock bag with a copy of your medical insurance card and taping it to the top inside of your saddlebag is a suggestion).
- Free Spirit Chapter Mileage Application. It's a fun way to keep track of the years and miles you've shared with the group 😊

Membership renewal information must be received NO LATER THAN March 31, 2020. If not received, you will no longer have access to the group Yahoo page . . . and will miss out on a LOT of very cool stuff for the 2020 riding season (3).

Free Spirit Chapter® Mileage Application (Optional)

FSC® offers mileage bars for their members. These represent the number of miles that have been ridden while being a chapter member. You can attain mileage bars in the following increments: 5,000; 10,000; 15,000; 25,000; 35,000; 50,000; 75,000 and 100,000. The riding year runs from November 1st and ends October 31st. Ending mileage must be turned in to Patricia no later than November 10th, and the results are announced at our Christmas party. To participate:

- 1. Complete an initial mileage tracking form (below). This is to establish your beginning mileage at the time you join.
- 2. When you have reached your personal milestone, contact Patricia and let her know which one you've earned*
- 3. Miles ridden on bikes other than your own (borrowing someone's bike, rentals on vacation, etc) can be counted toward your next bar. You must provide the make/model of the bike, location, and the number of miles driven.
- 4. In the event that you get a new bike, the starting mileage on the new bike must be given to Patricia in order for you to continue earning miles toward your next bar.
